FRIEDREICH'S ATAXIA

Research priorities in Friedreich's ataxia include:

- Advance understanding of neuroscience / neuro systems understanding the neurodegeneration of FA and implications for therapies
- Advance drug discovery, including research that would lead to target validation or to genetic, epigenetic and protein approaches that target increasing frataxin levels
- Development and validation of biomarkers, especially those that measure frataxin or the direct consequences of frataxin deficiency in affected tissue (CNS, muscle or cardiac)

A one-year grant for \$35,000 will be awarded based on qualification and scientific merit.

Format for the 1-page pre-application:

- Project title
- Applicant and Mentor Names, Titles, and associated institutions
- Brief statement of eligibility of Applicant
- Overall goal of the project
- Specific aims provided as a brief list
- Requested resources in terms of 1-year funding (total budget amount including 10% IDCs, if relevant to your institution)
- Attach CV of applicant

Full application is by invitation only after review of pre-application.
